

## CHS Softball Booster Club Meeting

President Bill Boynton called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Carol Boynton reported there is currently \$1740.20 in the checking account. A deposit recently included \$350 in donations for the "Dollars for Dugouts" project. Duke has ordered some socks and Freshman shirts.

### **President's Report**

Bill Boynton gave an update of the Memorial Field dugouts effort. The Voc-Ed class at Concord High is moving ahead with the construction project. There is up to \$1000 currently pledged or received towards a goal of \$3,000 to cover the cost of materials. Mike Goldsmith presented a \$500 check to the Softball Booster club on behalf of his family.

#### ***Budget for 2011***

Bill Boynton presented a proposed Booster Club budget for 2011. The budget had estimated revenues of \$11,050 and expenditures of \$8,488. Following review and discussion, the budget was approved as amended on a motion by Karen Sloper.

#### ***Tournaments***

- **Cape Cod Tournament** (April 2-3) – Coach Sawyer has paid the \$125 entry fee and will be reimbursed by the Booster Club.
- **Capital City Classic** – Tim Bill reported Pembroke Varsity and JV's are in. Bishop Brady and Bow are other possibilities. The umpires are all set. Joe Kennard has agreed to oversee concessions.
- **JV Tournament** – Continued interest expressed among booster club members for Concord to host the tournament on Memorial Day Weekend. Chris Kelleher will check with Goffstown AD to see if they are no longer hosting.

#### ***Fund Raising***

- A tag day for all three teams is tentatively set for April 16.
- Prize calendar is set to go – each player will be asked to sell at least 20. Prizes will be offered to the top sellers.

***Road Trip food vendor***

All set with Cimo's Market - \$6.25 per player per game. Each team will need to get money up front for the season. Check to be presented along with filled-out menu sheets.

***“Meet the Coaches Night”***

Coach Sawyer will confirm the date – either April 4 or 5. Packets for each player will be prepared and handed out with fundraising info, contact sheet, booster club info, etc.
