

CHS Softball Booster Club Meeting Minutes

May 12, 2011

President Bill Boynton called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Treasurer's Report

Carol Boynton reviewed the financial report and reported total revenue from the calendar sales was \$3,390. The total account balance is \$4,636.15.

On a motion by Tim Bill, the Treasurer's report was approved.

Dugout Project update

Carol Boynton reported that \$2,250 had been collected to date in the "Dollars for Dugouts" campaign and the Booster Club had contributed an additional \$2,166.49 in 2011 for construction materials. Additional construction work had been done on the roofs, with some work still remaining (benches, painting etc.). A final request for donations will be made in the *Monitor*.

Junior Varsity Tournament (Memorial Day Weekend):

- The field of teams is now set at 12. Looking at eight games on 5/28 and three on 5/29.
- The umpires are all set at total of \$120 per game = \$1,320 for the tourney.
- Tourney fees received to date - \$500 (at \$100 per team)
- A trainer has been secured by CHS for Saturday's games (5/28).
- Still unanswered questions about concessions and field maintenance.
- Athletic Director has requested concessions waiver from the city.
- It was agreed to order 75 tourney T-Shirts (@\$7.15 each) to sell for \$15 each.
- Will issue call for volunteers for concessions, public address, and game management.

Senior Night (May 25):

- Karen Kennard is taking care of senior gifts and flowers.
- Request for bios has been issued to six seniors.
- First pitches will be made by four CHS graduates who pitched state title victories.
- Charlie Temple has agreed to be the public address announcer for the event.
- Booster Club will provide food between games for Varsity and JV teams.
- Need to confirm photographer for senior family photos.
- Karen Sloper will pursue possible singer for the national anthem.
